Timmins High Alumni 1980 Homecoming Scholarships	Two scholarships (2 watches) were created from the proceeds of the Timmins High 1980 Homecoming.	Awarded to the 2 top graduating students of the academic Grade 13/12 program.
Timmins High Alumni Association scholarships	Created by the Timmins High Alumni Association which was established to assist in meeting the needs of TH&VS, following a very successful Homecoming in 2000.	2 scholarships: a) Awarded to a graduating student on the basis of the combination of good grades and contribution to the school. b) Awarded to a deserving student who demonstrates the qualities of commitment to education, hard work, industry and participation in school activities but without a grades component.
Shania Twain Scholarships	Created by Shania Twain, a graduate of TH&VS, to encourage students to work hard to pursue their goals.	Two scholarships: a) Awarded to a deserving graduating student from the Mattagami Reserve who is going on to post-secondary studies. b) Awarded to a deserving student who demonstrates commitment, determination and a willingness to work hard to achieve a goal.

Frank Graf Scholarship	In memory of Mr. Frank Graf, a knowledgeable and dedicated Timmins High teacher of English and Library for many years.	Awarded to a student who will be attending university to pursue a career in teaching.
Sean Graf Scholarship	In memory of Sean Graf, a former student of Timmins High	Awarded to a student who is going on to community college and pursuing a career working with children with disabilities.
Spooner Family Scholarship	In memory of Mr. Wilfrid Spooner, a former Timmins High student, who went to become a Member of the Provincial Parliament for the District of Cochrane South from 1956 to 1967.	Awarded to a deserving student who is going on to post-secondary studies at a community college.
Susan Hall Scholarship	In memory of Susan Hall, a former student at Timmins High, who was very talented and skilled in the area of music.	Awarded to a graduating student pursuing a career in music.
Margaret Clausi Memorial Scholarship	In memory of Mrs. Margaret (Peggy) Clausi, a graduate of TH&VS, elementary teacher for many years and wife of Ross Clausi, teacher and department head of History at TH&VS.	Awarded to a graduating student with top marks in Grade 12 academic English and History
Edward M. Collins Scholarship	In memory of Mr. Ed Collins, a compassionate and caring teacher in the TH&VS Business & Commerce Department for many years.	Awarded to a student who has a keen interest in Law & Justice
Lily Anderson Scholarship	In memory of Miss Lily Anderson who, for 25 years at TH&VS, was an exemplary teacher & department head of English.	Awarded to a graduating student with top marks in Grade 12 Academic English
Rita Seccombe Scholarship	In memory of Miss Rita Seccombe, an art teacher, who began her long career at TH&VS in 1974. An accomplished artist herself, many of Rita's paintings hang in offices and homes throughout Timmins.	Awarded to a graduating student who is pursuing a career in the area of the arts.
Bruno Toffanello Scholarship	In memory of Bruno Toffanello, a caring and compassionate auto mechanics teacher and Director of Technological Studies	Awarded to a student who is pursuing a career in technology
